Stock up on comfy, loose-fitting clothes that won't tug at incisions, and prepare simple meals or freezer-friendly options to cut down on kitchen time. In the bathroom, consider a raised toilet seat, shower chair, non-slip mats, and a hand-held shower head.

Elevating a surgical leg as directed, using ice correctly, and sipping water throughout the day all support your body's healing from the inside out.
